Polling by Savanta for the Conservative Drug Policy Reform Group 07 June - 27 July 2021


Three quarters or more MPs (even within the Conservative party) believe that it is time to update UK drug laws based on evidence.

A majority of MPs (even within the Conservative party) do not believe current policies are effective and believe that we need to change how drugs policies are made.

90% of MPs, and 85% of conservative MPs believe improved crossdepartmental coordination of drug policy would better tackle problems caused by controlled drugs.


105 MPs were asked the extent to which they **agree or disagree** with the following statements
